



Representative Elections – Spring 2019

Thank you for your interest in running! Representatives are responsible for representing students on Council through reporting ideas and concerns registered by these students back to Council, and are to sit on various committees and commissions. Representatives may also be ratified as a Deputy Commissioner on one of the commissions in order to take a greater role on that commission. Representatives must also hold regular office hours and attend regular council meetings. All representatives are expected to represent as well as promote and encourage the involvement of their constituents in college activities and programs.

In order to be eligible, candidates must submit this nomination to the UC Lit office (inside the Junior Common Room) by *Wednesday, March 20th, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. sharp.*

- **Six (6) Mid Year Representative** positions are open to registered University College students who will be in their second or third year of study (by credits) in the 2019-20 school year.
- **Three (3) Upper Year Representative** positions are open to registered University College students who will be in their fourth year of study (by credits) in the 2019-20 school year.

It is highly recommended that before running for any position, you speak to current office-holders and read the governing documents outlining the responsibilities of these positions.

The complete description of Representative responsibilities can be found in Chapter 2 of the UC Lit Policy Book, which is available on the UC Lit website, uclit.ca/about-us/documents.

Two All-Candidates' Meetings will be held on Wednesday, March 20th, 2019 at 5:00 pm and 9:00 pm in the JCR. Attendance at one of these meetings is mandatory. At the meeting, all candidates must submit a \$10 Election Bond. The terms of that bond and its return will be discussed at that time. Failure to attend and provide a \$10 Election Bond will result in disqualification, unless the Elections Coordinator has been informed at least 24 hours in advance.
