Hey everyone! Apart from the design/meme contest in January for the new sticker (and memes), soliciting new ideas for next year, and obviously selling spirit wear, the “spirit” part of the commission is dunzo for the year. Thanks to everyone who helped design and narrow possible designs to the ones we ended up ordering. Patches have arrived, hoodies will be here any day now, and the water bottles, phone wallets and new beanies will ship Friday. Socks should arrive around the beginning of December. We’ll be strategizing new ways to sell our products, including an exciting, Aster-suggested “holiday catalogue” photo series for social media, for which we hope you want to help us model! With the Alumni Office’s cooperation, we sold spirit wear at the fall convocation reception during Reading Week, which is hopefully something SCC can continue for the June convocation reception!

For the rest of the year, we’re going to be focusing almost exclusively on the “communications” part of the commission! When not ordering spirit wear this month, we mainly focused on writing newsletters, assisting with promo for many of the then-current Lit events, and of course trying to ride the wave of meme magic and school spirit that you all remember happened in late October. (We’ve even created the option for students to submit UC-related memes in that style for us to post lol). I had meetings with my deputies and ratified reps over reading week to regroup, and to refine and plan out how we want to do this in the coming months. We have numerous social media campaigns in the works, signups for which can be found in the Social Media subgroup on Facebook if you want to help. SpoonU, a student run food blog at UofT, is curating a list of Toronto food spots for us to highlight on the social media during exams, in alternation with the regular study spots feature. To conserve UC Lit social media airspace and to more directly interact with students, we’ll be doing more direct personal recruitment this and next month for the Blog and Sponsorship subteams, the latter of which will be headed by Danyal and will be kicking into gear in December, the framework having been decided this month during a meeting between us. This month we’re going to come up with a plan for upkeep of the poster boards in the JCR, and try to work with admin on better poster options in the Fung hallway. We’re also planning a RIRI social with the UCRC Social Directors, so that reps and presidents can toss around collaboration ideas in a fun, informal setting. Finally, I’ll be sending all the reps emails this week to inquire about RIRI updates, constructive criticisms and ways we can help improve this part of the rep job this year and going forward. I hope to bring some of these to admin to begin pushing for changes that can help increase collaboration between the UC Lit and UC Residence/Student Life staff, including more awareness for dons of the UC Lit and seeing if some UC Lit events can qualify for house points. Let’s also not forget about the resources section on the website and other website redevelopments!
