First Year Residence/Off-Campus Rep Election // Upper Year Residence Rep By-Election

- **Three First Year Residence Representative positions** are available for current UC students who live in a UC residence during the present school year.
- **Three First Year Off-Campus Representative positions** are available for current UC students who do not live in a UC residence during the present school year.
- **One Upper Year On-Campus Representative position** is available for current UC students who are not in first year; who lived in a UC residence from March 15-April 2, 2009 OR are living in a UC residence at present.

Responsibilities of representatives: Responsibilities of the representative position are outlined in Chapter 2 of the council policies available in the UC Lit office. A brief overview of this chapter includes, but not limited to the following responsibilities: attending weekly office hours, monthly meeting attendance, commission participation and event participation/planning amongst others. It is recommended that you review these duties to avoid any unpleasant surprises.

In order to be eligible, candidates must submit this nomination form to the Lit office by Wednesday, Sept 16 2009 at 4:00 p.m. Students may submit a nomination form for only one of the listed positions.

Two All-Candidates' Meetings will be held on Wednesday, Sept 16 2009 at 5:00 p.m and at 9 p.m. in the JCR. **Attendance at one of the meetings is mandatory** (you only need to attend one); failure to attend will result in ineligibility. In addition, an elections bond of **\$20 must be submitted at the candidates' meeting.** The terms of the bond and its return will be discussed at the meeting.
